Main Script

**age versus ī: When "go" really means "to act," use age. When you "go fish," you are going to a place (the deck) in order "to fish" for a card, therefore use ī.*

I have one/two/three/four 6s.

ego ūnum seniōnem // duōs / trēs / quattuor seniōnēs habeō.

Say goodbye to your cards as you hand them over.

Goodbye, 2! / Goodbye, 2s!

valē (s.), **bīniō!** / **valēte** (pl), **bīniōnēs!**

Try using different tenses.

I used to have (was having) one queen, but now I have no queens.

ego ūnam rēgīnam habēbam, sed nunc nullās rēgīnās habeō.
